

REGULATIONS OF THE “ŻYWIECKIE SUWAKOWANIE” MUSIC WORKSHOPS

§1. General Provisions

1. The organizer of the “Żywieckie Suwakowanie” Music Workshops, hereinafter referred to as the “Workshops”, is the ASSOCIATION FOR THE PROMOTION OF BRASS INSTRUMENT PERFORMANCE “ŻYWIECKIE SUWAKOWANIE”, based in Żywiec, Poland.
2. The purpose of the Workshops is to develop participants’ musical skills, promote musical culture and integrate the musical community.
3. The Workshops shall take place at the time and location specified by the Organizer.

§2. Conditions of Participation

1. Participation in the Workshops is voluntary.
2. Participation requires:
 - a) submission of the registration form;
 - b) acceptance of these Regulations;
 - c) submission of the required personal data processing consents in accordance with the GDPR;
 - d) payment of the participation fee determined by the Organizer;
 - e) for minors, submission of a signed Responsibility Form by a parent or legal guardian.
3. Adult participants take part in the Workshops at their own responsibility.
4. Participants under the age of 15 may participate only under the supervision of a parent or legal guardian.
5. Participants aged 15 to 18 may participate independently provided that a Responsibility Form signed by a parent or legal guardian has been submitted.
6. Failure to provide the required documents or failure to pay the participation fee may result in refusal of participation.

§3. Organizer’s Obligations

1. The Organizer shall provide appropriate organizational and technical conditions necessary for conducting the Workshops.
2. The Organizer shall ensure the safety of participants during classes, rehearsals, concerts and other events included in the official Workshop program.
3. The Organizer acts in accordance with the Child Protection Standards adopted by the Association.

§4. Participants' Obligations

1. Participants are required to:
 - a) comply with these Regulations;
 - b) follow the instructions of the Organizer and workshop instructors;
 - c) observe the principles of social conduct;
 - d) take care of entrusted property and accommodation facilities.
2. The following are prohibited:
 - a) consumption or possession of alcohol, narcotics or other intoxicating substances;
 - b) violation of the law;
 - c) aggressive behavior or conduct endangering others;
 - d) destruction of property;
 - e) behavior violating accepted standards of conduct.
3. The Organizer reserves the right to exclude participants who violate these Regulations.
4. In the case of a minor participant, the parent or legal guardian is obliged to immediately collect the participant from the Workshop venue. Transportation costs shall be borne by the participant or their legal guardian.

§5. Liability

1. The Organizer and workshop instructors are responsible for participants during classes, rehearsals, concerts and other events included in the Workshop program.
2. During free time not covered by the official Workshop program, adult participants are responsible for their own conduct.
3. Parents or legal guardians are responsible for minor participants, taking into account the Organizer's responsibility during official Workshop activities.
4. The Organizer shall not be liable for items left unattended, their loss or damage.
5. The Organizer shall not be liable for damages caused by participants to third parties.

§6. Accommodation and Material Liability

1. Participants using accommodation facilities are obliged to comply with the rules applicable at the accommodation venue.
2. Participants are financially liable for any damage caused by them to accommodation facilities or other premises used during the Workshops.
3. Parents or legal guardians of minors are liable for damages caused by their children.

§7. Withdrawal and Exclusion

1. Applications are accepted electronically.
2. Withdrawal from participation does not entitle the participant to a refund of the participation fee unless otherwise decided by the Organizer.
3. Failure to submit the Responsibility Form for a minor participant may result in refusal of participation.

§8. Child Protection

1. The Organizer applies the Child Protection Standards adopted by the Association.
2. All persons involved in the organization of the Workshops are required to comply with these Standards.

§9. Personal Data and Image Rights

1. The controller of participants' personal data is the ASSOCIATION FOR THE PROMOTION OF BRASS INSTRUMENT PERFORMANCE "ŻYWIECKIE SUWAKOWANIE", with its registered office at Os. 700-Lecia 18/103, 34-300 Żywiec, Poland.
2. Personal data are processed for the purpose of organizing, conducting and promoting the Workshops in accordance with the GDPR.
3. Participation in the Workshops requires submission of the necessary consents regarding personal data processing and image rights, which constitute separate documents.
4. During the Workshops, photographs, audio recordings and video recordings may be made for documentation, promotional and statutory purposes of the Organizer.
5. Detailed rules concerning personal data processing are specified in a separate GDPR Information Clause.

§10. Final Provisions

1. These Regulations constitute an integral part of the participant's registration for the Workshops.
2. Matters not regulated herein shall be governed by Polish law.
3. The Organizer reserves the right to amend these Regulations.
4. Participation in the Workshops constitutes acceptance of these Regulations.
